3 Paise



These coins were minted for a very short period i.e. from 1964 to 1971. We firmly believe that because these coins were minted for a very short time, they will soon become rare.

On the Obverse of these beautiful coins there is Lion Capital of Ashoka in the centre surrounded by the legend "Bharat" and "India" towards the left and right respectively. On the Reverse side of this coin the denomination '3' is inscribed in the centre, text "teen paise" in Devanagari on the top and a floral design on both the sides. Year of minting is written just below the numeral denomination 3 and mint mark just below the years.

The mint mark used by the Mumbai Mint was a diamond, Hyderabad Mint can be identified by the dot in diamond from 1964-66 and star from 1967-71. As usual the absence of any mint mark was representative of the Kolkata mint.
